2018 North Carolina State Superintendent's Arts Initiative

The State Superintendent of North Carolina Public Schools is sponsoring a statewide arts initiative. The Superintendent's Arts Initiative is an opportunity to recognize student artists and to encourage participation in all of the arts throughout the state, as well as in each Local Education Agency (LEA). The initiative is open to all K-12 public school students in all arts disciplines (Dance, Music, Theatre Arts, and Visual Arts.) All two-dimensional artwork such as painting, drawing, printmaking, and photography, will be displayed permanently in the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction in Raleigh. Local Education Agencies may submit one work per LEA.

Guidelines:

Content

- Dance, Music, and Theatre Arts can be portrayed through the Visual Arts or documented through Photography. Visual Art does not have to illustrate the other arts and can use any topic or theme.
- Any work must comply with community standards and if deemed offensive, will not be displayed.
- Three-dimensional, low relief artwork will not be accepted.

Display

- In order to be displayed, the Student Release Form and Originality Certification (below) need to be completed and must accompany the artwork.
- Instead of framing artwork, please mount the artwork on black mat board. If black mat board is unavailable, NCDPI will mat the work for you.
- Please note that artwork and mat must be no larger than 20 inches by 32 inches to the outside of the mat. Printed photography should be no larger than 18 inches by 12.25 inches.
- Photographs should be printed and mounted on foam board. If this is not possible you may send a high quality JPEG file, RAW file, or a link to file to slater.mapp@dpi.nc.gov for printing at NCDPI.

Selection Process for Consideration:

1. At each school a selection process will be developed to determine the one piece of ART work that the school would like to submit for consideration. (one submission per school ONLY)
2. The piece for submission must meet the guidelines listed above for content and display.
3. The application form must be signed by the student, parent and art teacher. (It will not be considered if the application form is not signed.)
4. All county-wide submissions for consideration must be submitted in Dr. Cindy Corcoran's office by Wednesday, April 11th at 5:00 pm. with the student's name, grade, art teacher and school name.
5. The selection committee at CO will determine from the pieces submitted the winner and notify the student, art teacher and the school by Friday, April 13, 2018.
